## **Membership Card and Stickers -**

All members should have their membership sticker visible on their bag and carry their membership card. Do not be offended if you are asked to produce proof of membership either in the bar or on the course. To meet legal and financial obligations requests for proof of membership may be made at any time. Members must sign in guests in the visitors book at the lounge entrance before guests can use the licensed area.

## **Look after your Golf Course**

Carry a bucket of dirt and fill in divots with soil.

Repair pitch marks on the green.

Rake sand bunkers after playing your shot out of the bunker.

Avoid walking with your trundler between the green and sand bunkers or grass mounds.

Do not use your putter head to remove the ball from the cup.

Repair or fill in divots on all tees especially Par 3's.

Practice areas are east of No. 6 green, between No. 11 and No. 13 fairways, north of No. 6 fairway and green and a netted hit-up bays west of No.10 tee.

Practice is also allowed on Torepe Fields.

Give way to Green Keeper and mowing activity.

## **Membership Type and Annual Subscription for October 1st 2024 to September 30th 2025**

<b>Full 18 hole</b>	<b>\$540.00</b>	Full playing rights for 18 hole play and handicap, including all club trophy events.
<b>Full 9 Hole</b>	<b>\$385.00</b>	Full playing rights for 9 hole play and handicap, including all 9 hole club trophy events.
<b>Non Club Day</b>	<b>\$375.00</b>	18 hole restricted playing rights, not eligible for Handicap or play in club or tournament fixtures.
<b>18 hole Summer</b>	<b>\$375.00</b>	18 hole playing rights restricted to period that day-light saving applies. Eligible for Handicap, not eligible for club trophy events eg. club championships, Shootout.
<b>9 hole Summer</b>	<b>\$280.00</b>	9 hole playing rights restricted to period that daylight saving applies. Eligible for Handicap, not eligible for club trophy events eg. club championships.
<b>18 hole Winter</b>	<b>\$335.00</b>	18 hole playing rights restricted to period that daylight saving does not apply. Eligible for handicap, not eligible for club trophy events eg. club championships, shootout.
<b>Junior Under 19</b>	<b>\$175.00</b>	(At Secondary School or Tertiary) Can play club events with approval of committee.
<b>Junior Under 14</b>	<b>\$85.00</b>	Can play Club events with approval of committee.
<b>Associate Members</b>	<b>\$240.00</b>	Must be full member of another club and handicapped at that club. Not eligible for Club Trophies or shootout.
<b>Social Members</b>	<b>\$40.00</b>	No Playing rights.
<b>12 month new member discount</b>		\$100.00

For full year subscriptions Members can pay in full by the due date or can take the option of monthly automatic payments over 6 months - October to March. A \$10 surcharge will apply to automatic

payments. Where members have not paid by the due date or monthly payments are in default, playing rights will be suspended and the handicap removed from the system until payment is made.

## **Green Fees and Motorised Cart Hire Fees**

### **Green Fees**

Adult (Unaffiliated)	18 holes - \$30.00	9 holes - \$20.00
Adult (Affiliated)	18 holes - \$25.00	9 holes - \$15.00
Junior U/18	18 holes - \$10.00	9 holes - \$6.00

Green fee players playing in a club day competition will pay \$15 for 18 holes and \$9.00 for 9 holes (plus the competition fee).

### **Cart Fees**

Members	18 holes \$15.00	9 holes \$10.00
Non Members	18 holes OR 9 holes	\$30.00

Carts are only available for visitors when playing in competitions/tournaments and when playing with a member.

Hire conditions for motorised cart are displayed in the change rooms and with the booking sheet. Carts can be booked on the sheet in the folder which is kept in the Green Fee Box.

Members please ensure you, or visitors you bring to the course, complete documentation related to green fees and cart hire. Members should ensure payments with the payment receipt are made prior to the round and the cart hirers receipt or green fee receipt is displayed on the cart.

Please read the cart operating guidelines on the yellow hirer's receipt and ensure you or visitors follow these guidelines.

Members should be aware that club policy is that visitors playing in the club competitions pay the competition entry fee in addition to the reduced green fees noted above.

### **Reciprocal Rights**

Temuka Golf Club men and Geraldine Golf Club men have automatic reciprocal rights to play in each others mid week competition. The Geraldine Golf Club is on Wednesday afternoon and the Temuka Golf Club is on Thursday afternoon. There are no other automatic rights organised with any other club. However, other clubs may be granted rights to play on a one off occasion, this will be advised to the organiser of the competition of the day. Currently Pleasant Point Golf Club and Geraldine Golf Club members are granted rights on a case by case basis for specific occasions such as when their course is closed for a tournament or for maintenance. Temuka Golf Club has a similar arrangement with those clubs on the same basis if the need arises.

## Guide to all Members

1. Players should move briskly between shots. When the last player has putted, move away from the green before filling in the score card.
2. Players losing one clear hole in front should let the following players through.
3. Replace all divots and heel in solidly. Where the divot cannot be replaced, heel in the divot mark from each side or carry a dirt bucket and fill in divots with dirt. Repair pitch marks on greens.
4. Watch flight of partner's drives and note where they finish.
5. Remain motionless and silent whilst others are preparing to hit.
6. Generally the player furthest from the flag plays first but a closer player may play first to prevent a delay and speed up play.
7. When attending the flag, keep your feet as far from the hole as possible and keep shadow away from hole and line of putt. Avoid walking on putt line of other players in your group.
8. Smooth out foot and divot marks in bunkers with rake provided.
9. Avoid pulling golf carts between bunkers/mounds and the green especially when conditions are wet.
10. Do not mark cards on the green, wait until you are on the next tee. Person with honour should tee off first before marking card.
11. Players with motorised bikes and carts should not go within 10m of any green and avoid any wet areas on the course.
12. Please keep your course tidy.
13. Users of motorised carts must comply with policies, procedures and instructions related to hire and use of carts on the course.

**DRESS:** Players are requested to maintain a reasonable standard of dress.

## **Mens Club Trophies and Conditions of Matches**

**Club Stroke Championship:** Five grades, best combined gross score over the 3 stroke championship rounds. Players must play the 3 rounds to be eligible.

**Club Matchplay Championships:** Five grades, to qualify the best two rounds over the 3 Stroke Championship rounds are used, then the match play championship commences (all on gross score) starting with a maximum of 16 players (but may be less). Players are seeded in order of their 2 round qualifying gross scores.

**Trevelyan Cup:** Best two nett scores over the 3 stroke championship rounds.

**SF Martin Cup:** Open Fourball best ball nett, own partner, match play on handicap.

**JD Crisp Cup:** Singles Knockout, open entry, match play on handicap.

**Taylor Flight:** Open to players eliminated from first two rounds of Singles Knockout. Match play on handicap.

**Stokes Cup Ringer:** Best nett for each hole over five rounds.

**Jolly Potter Shootout:** Best nett over the field on the nominated qualifying day of each month, Feb-Nov qualifies. The 10 qualifiers play off over 9 holes on handicap with highest nett score (or loser of any tie break) on each hole eliminated until one player (winner) remains.

### **Temuka Hammer Hardware Super Stableford Challenge:**

Played over 8 rounds. To qualify for final: must have 5 rounds scoring out of the 8 rounds. Scores on finals day will be doubled and added to the 5 qualifying rounds to find the winner. Ties for first on qualifying rounds to be decided by chip-off. Ties for placings on finals day to be decided by chip-off.

**Temuka 2000:** Own partner, best nett over three rounds, two ball best ball nett on day 1 and combined netts on day 2. If tied, first score counts; if still tied best Sunday nett score counts.



**McCully Trophy:** Summer nett, best three netts out of five rounds played.

**Simpson Trophy:** Thursday Men's Competition

## **RULES**

**Trophy Competitions Dates:** All Championships, qualifying and club trophy rounds must be played on or by the date stipulated and the winners names entered on the draw sheet by the due date. The trophy competitions take precedence over the competition of the day. Championship Finals to be played on designated finals day.

**Jolly Potter Shootout:** When there is a tie for the best monthly nett score the winner will be decided by a chip-off. This will also apply to replacements as below Qualifiers must play the final. If a qualifier is not available the person with next best score for that month will replace.

This programme is liable to alteration at the discretion of the Match Committee.

Members who have not paid subscriptions by the due date will lose playing rights and have handicap removed from board.

## **Types of Matches**

**Stroke** - each player against the field, all strokes taken counted.

**Medal or Nett** - each player against the field, all strokes counted and handicap deducted.

**Match Play** - player v player, can be played as stroke or nett. A player wins a hole when they have less strokes or nett strokes than their opponent. The match is won when one player is more holes ahead than there are holes left to play.

**Stableford** - take your handicap allowance at the hole it occurs on the card from the strokes you have on that hole then score 1 point for a nett 1 over par, 2 points for a nett par, 3 points for a nett birdie (-1), 4 points for a nett eagle (-2), or 5 points for a nett albatross (-3).

**Par** - You must take your handicap allowance at the holes it occurs on the card. Take your handicap allowance from the strokes you have on the hole and mark a win for a nett birdie or better, a half for a nett par and a loss for a nett 1 over.

**Bisque Par** - You may take your handicap allowance where you please. You must nominate after holing out and before teeing off whether you wish to use 1 or more strokes. Nominate the handicap allowance you wish to use and take this from the strokes you have had on the hole and mark a win for a nett birdie or better, a half for a nett par and a loss for a nett 1 over.

**Fourball Best Ball** - played as pairs, best score of either two partners counts. Scoring can be stroke, nett, stableford or par.

**Fourball Best Ball Match** - played as pairs, best stroke or nett score of either two partners counts against best stroke or nett score of either opponents. Holes are won, halved or lost. The match is won when one pair is more holes ahead than there are holes left to play.

**Foursomes** - played in pairs, partners alternate with tee shots and then subsequent shots to hole out. Half combined handicap to be used.

**Canadian Foursome** - Both partners drive, then one drive is selected and played out with alternate shots. Half combined handicap to be used.

**Greensome** - Both partners play 2 shots then select one ball and play out with alternate shots. Half combined handicap to be used.

**American Foursome** - Both partners tee off, then they hit each others drive. One ball is selected for the 3rd shot and players hit alternate shots until holed out.

**Ambrose** - teams of 3 or 4. All players drive then select the ball for the 2nd shot. All players hit from that spot. This continues until holed out. There may be some restrictions in the format eg. maximum number of drives a player can have, order of play, player whose shot is taken cannot play next shot, combined handicap divided by 5, 6, 7 or 8, so check rules in place for each event.

**Scramble** - 2 man Ambrose. Both tee off, then select one ball and both hit from there again, this continues until holed out.

**Medalford** - each player will score a gross score and a stableford score for each hole. At the end of the round the player will calculate the nett score and total the stableford. The Medalford score is the net score less the stableford score, eg. 69 nett less 36 stableford points = 33 medalford. Lowest score wins.

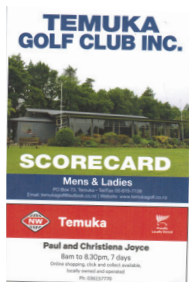
